# Snapper Rock Pinot Noir 2020 Marlborough, New Zealand

#### WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Sourced from our vineyard in the sub region of Ward Valley, southern Marlborough, blessed with deep clay loam soils and traces of limestone.

After a challenging start, the 2020 vintage was saved by an amazing Indian summer with perfect late conditions. A curve ball was thrown at the 11<sup>th</sup> hour, with NZ going into Level 4 lockdown just as harvest began. Resisting the temptation to pick early due to the pressures of lockdown, we held off, allowing the fruit to hang and create the perfect balance of ripeness and acidity. Harvest started at 3am on the 15<sup>th</sup> of April 2020 Fruit was then taken to Spring Creek and hand plunged in open top fermenters, before being transferred to a mixture of small tank and seasoned French oak barrels.
